AGREED ORDER CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF JEWELRY TO COURT-APPOINTED RECEIVER

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2019, the Court appointed Jeffrey C. Schneider, Esq. as the Receiver of Argyle Coin, LLC (the "Order"). ECF No. 20.

WHEREAS, the Receiver has demanded that 38 pieces of jewelry in the custody, control or possession of non-party Carmelo De Stefano (the "Jewelry") be turned over to him in his capacity as Receiver. The Jewelry is discussed and listed in Mr. De Stefano's letter, including its exhibits, to the Receiver dated May 7, 2019.

WHEREAS, Mr. De Stefano takes the position that he has a perfected ownership interest

in the Jewelry and that no order entered in this or any other proceeding requires him to turn over

the Jewelry to the Receiver and reserves all rights and does not waive any defenses with respect to

his ownership interest in the Jewelry and his right to retain custody, control and/or possession of

the Jewelry.

WHEREAS, the Receiver reserves the right to dispute any of Mr. De Stefano's positions

regarding the Jewelry.

WHEREAS, however, for purposes of promoting efficiency and judicial economy, Mr.

De Stefano agrees to turn over custody of the Jewelry to the Receiver under the condition that an

Agreed Order be entered by this Court providing that: (1) the Jewelry is transferred to the

Receiver's possession solely for the purpose of appraisal and safekeeping; (2) the Jewelry will not

be distributed, sold, or disposed of by the Receiver without a court order or stipulation of the

parties; (3) the Jewelry must be maintained in a safe deposit box by the Receiver; and (4) if the

Receiver and Mr. De Stefano cannot mutually agree on De Stefano's ownership interest and/or

right to possess the Jewelry, such issues will be adjudicated by the Court, with there being no

presumption against Mr. De Stefano or in favor of the Receiver by virtue of the fact that Mr. De

Stefano transferred possession to the Receiver pursuant to this Agreed Order.

WHEREAS, the Court, being advised of the parties' agreement and being fully advised in

the premises, orders that the Jewelry be transferred to the Receiver's possession pursuant to the

terms herein within five (5) business days of entry of this Agreed Order.
